

In an effort to reduce the ongoing problem of plastic shopping bags littering our landfills, landscapes and clogging our waterways, Deputy Clerk/Recycling Coordinator Barbara Kovelesky has purchased, through the Clean Communities Grant, reusable shopping bags for Holmdel residents to use for their shopping needs. If a resident brings 20 or more plastic shopping bags to the Clerk's office between the hours of 9:00 am - 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday two reusable bags per resident address will be given in exchange for the 20 plastic bags. The bags will send the message to fellow shoppers that Holmdel and their residents care about our environment. The plastic bags will be recycled through Goodwill Industries. Goodwill recycles the bags through their "BagSmart" program.
