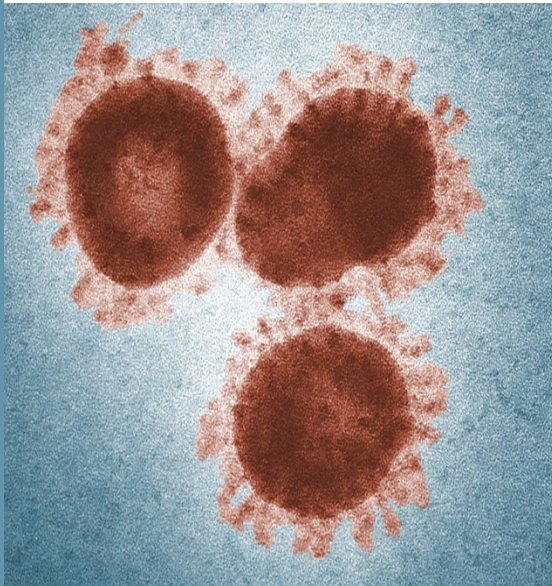

### WHAT YOU CAN DO NOW!

- DON'T PANIC!
- WASH HANDS OFTEN WITH SOAP AND WATER. IF NOT AVAILABLE, USE HAND SANITIZER
- AVOID TOUCHING YOUR EYES, NOSE, OR MOUTH WITH UNWASHED HANDS
- AVOID CONTACT WITH PEOPLE WHO ARE SICK
- STAY HOME WHILE YOU ARE SICK AND AVOID CONTACT WITH OTHERS
- COVER YOUR MOUTH AND NOSE WITH A TISSUE OR SLEEVE WHEN COUGHING OR SNEEZING
- HAVE A SUPPLY OF WATER AND NON-PERISHABLE FOOD ON HAND IN THE EVENT THAT YOU GET SICK
- ENSURE YOU HAVE A CONTINUOUS SUPPLY OF REGULARLY NEEDED PRESCRIPTIONS, NONPRESCRIPTION DRUGS AND OTHER HEALTH SUPPLIES
- LOCATE AND STORE COPIES OF PERSONAL HEALTH RECORDS
- IDENTIFY ARRANGEMENTS FOR CARE OF CHILDREN OR THE ELDERLY SHOULD SCHOOLS/OFFICES CLOSE
- HAVE A PLAN WITH LOVED ONES ON HOW TO RECEIVE CARE SHOULD ANYONE GET SICK
- AVOID TRAVELING TO PLACES WITH WIDESPREAD OR SUSTAINED COMMUNITY TRANSMISSION
- THE CDC DOES NOT RECOMMEND THE USE OF FACE MASKS FOR THE GENERAL U.S. PUBLIC
