Message from Mayor Buontempo:

Good evening. This is Mayor Greg Buontempo.

Tonight we have 56 reported cases of coronavirus amongst Holmdel residents. As you know, we expect this number to increase. Rather than continuing to raise already heightened emotions by reporting the growing list, we will be providing the updated count at the bottom of each of our written releases. Those who would like to know each day can visit our site.

I remind everyone that we are still collecting donations of Personal Protective Equipment. We have received an outpouring of donations including, among other items, approximately 250 N95 masks, over 1000 surgical masks, over 1000 pairs of gloves, hand sanitizer and cleaners. We are most appreciative for these donations. Nevertheless, as this pandemic continues to spread, our first responders and hospital are still in need of this critical gear.

Finally, tonight, Bayshore Medical Center still needs medical professionals who are willing and able to join their team. With new patients arriving every day, the regular staff is being greatly taxed. Additional qualified personnel are needed to help.
