## Message from Mayor Buontempo:

Good evening. This is Mayor Greg Buontempo.

As we continue through Phase Two of the State's Restart and Recovery plan, we continue to see progress. In Holmdel there are 57 active cases, of which 50 are in long term care facilities.

The Holmdel Township Committee approved temporary outdoor dining, and we have had several restaurants already open this week. We will maintain a list of these restaurants on our website. Additionally, in-person, non-essential retail is now open on a limited basis. I urge everyone to support the businesses in our community.

Holmdel Township has also decided to open our Swim Club in early July. Limited memberships are available, and open exclusively for Holmdel residents through Sunday.

Finally, on Monday, youth sports practices can resume, and Holmdel Township will be opening up our fields for our local teams.

While these are great signs, we still must be smart and continue to practice good hygiene and social distancing. Remember to wear a mask and minimize gatherings. Those high-risk individuals who can stay at home, should continue to do so.
